Safety Solutions

Now They're Pretending To Be Us



Not too long ago, we learned that the scammers have been calling people around the city pretending to be one of our sergeants, and sometimes, our police chief, Fred Hofer.

It's called the Imposter Scam, where the fraudsters pose as representatives from the Coconut Creek Police Department to try and convince you to give them

something they want. Luckily, at the time of this writing, we don't know of any actual victims from this scam. From what we're being told, the people who get this phone call are asked for personal information, such as dates of birth or social security numbers. This is an obvious attempt to steal identities.

We've had some residents tell us that the scam artists are also posing as officials from City Hall, such as administration, and asking for personal information using that tactic. Again, it's all a scam.

No one from City Hall or the Police Department, or any other city department for that matter, would ever call you asking for personal information or money.

Unfortunately, the Imposter Scam happens to many police departments, sheriff's offices, and government agencies. One of the favorite tactics the bad guys like to use is to pose as IRS or Social Security Administration agents during tax return season, preying on the victim's fears of inadvertently doing something wrong on their tax forms.

We alerted the public to the scammers using our name back in early August. Once the imposters see that, it usually takes care of it, but, with these slimy scam artists, you never know.

If you get a phone call like this, just hang up.

You can report it to us on our non-emergency line, 954-346-4400. Even if you didn't give them any information, we'd like to know the scam attempts are still happening.

If you did give them any personal information, you need to call us immediately. You can use 911 or the non-emergency number.

At this point it seems the scammers are "phishing" for personal information. Phishing means they are looking for potential victims to give them personal information so they can use that to steal identities. If you give them enough of your information for example, they could use it to open up a credit card under your name.

We have not heard of the fraudsters trying to convince people to buy gift cards, which is always a dead giveaway that it's a scam.

Remember that anytime you are asked to buy gift cards for any reason, it's always a scam.

This escalation in the scam operation, meaning the scammers trying to get you to give them money, might have been the next step for the bad guys until we intervened.

As much as we don't like it, the Imposter Scam must work or else why would the scam artists bother continuing to use it?

The bottom line is that anytime someone calls or emails you out of the blue, asking for personal information or trying to scare you that you've neglected to pay some bill, or you're involved in some type of crime, it's always a scam. Just hang up if it's a phone call. If it's an email or text message, just delete it.

Be a good Neighbor. Look out for each other!

Legal Plan Checklist To Protect Yourself By Martin Zevin, Attorney

I have touched on these subjects in many articles. Here is a condensed checklist.

1. Current Advanced Care Directives:

A. Designation of Health Care Surrogate for someone to make your medical decisions if you cannot communicate. Even if you are married, you MUST have this legal document and it needs to be current and done by a Florida lawyer. Do NOT rely on generic forms or a document you got from your doctor or a hospital or out of state documents.

B. Living Will. Very specific Florida language regarding "pulling the plug." Must be witnessed and notarized and designate someone to make the final decision.

C. Durable Power of Attorney. Covers legal and financial matters while you are alive. Again, needs to be done by a lawyer who is aware of current Florida law, including many specific powers that must be initialed by you to be valid. Our current document is 26 pages. When you die, the advanced care directives die with you.

2. Last Will and Testament. If you are a Florida resident, you should have a Florida Will and your Personal Representative (Executor) must be a Florida resident OR a blood relative.

3. If you own real estate, in Florida or elsewhere, you need one of these to avoid probate when you die.

A. Life Estate Deed. You own property for the rest of your life and you designate someone on the Deed to inherit it without probate when you die. Be sure it is an "enhanced" (also known as "Lady Bird") Deed to allow you to sell it without consent or joinder of the person you name.

B. Trust and Deed transferring property to you (and your spouse) as Trustee(s) of your Trust. This allows you to name contingent beneficiaries if your first choice dies before you or with you in a common accident. The Revocable Living Trust also allows you to buy future properties as Trustee



and to Amend the Trust at any time while you are alive. The Deed to your home should have language confirming that it remains your homestead.

Talk to your lawyer about the risks of a Life Estate Deed versus no risks for the Trust.

The above documents should be done with the assistance of an Estate Planning Attorney. The following need to be done by you personally:

4. Designate beneficiaries on ALL of your accounts to avoid probate. This is also known as payable on death (p.o.d.), transfer on death (t.o.d.) or in trust for (i.t.f.). Also designate contingent beneficiaries. Each institution has its own forms

but it should not cost you anything except some time.

5. If you know that you want to be cremated or buried, contact cremation societies or funeral homes to discuss pre-need plans. You will be signing a contract to pre-pay for your funeral, saving your loved ones a lot of stress, time and money. Be sure to give a copy of your contract to your primary and contingent Personal Representative so they will know who to call.

6. Have car insurance that includes at least \$100,000 of bodily injury liability (b.i.) and uninsured motorist (u.m.). Do not have any deductible on your P.I.P. (no fault). If you own more than one car, consider "stacking", which allows you to double (two cars) or triple (three cars) your uninsured motorist coverage for a small additional premium. Uninsured motorist is the most important insurance you can have, since Florida does not require bodily injury coverage.

If you do all the homework on this list, you are well on your way to getting an "A" in Legalities of Life 101.





In early 2020, while driving home, I came across a car that failed to move after the traffic light turned green. Despite the honking of other drivers and myself, the vehicle remained stationary. Recognizing a potential emergency, I acted quickly.

Jose Clemente Orozco Mural, "The Epic of American Civilization" At Dartmouth

This summer, I revisited the Baker Library on the campus of Dartmouth University in Hanover, New Hampshire. I carefully studied the Orozco Mural, "The Epic of American Civilization" with its 24 panels. Jose Orozco was an outstanding Mexican Muralist. Jose Orozco produced this iconic mural between 1932 and 1934. The theme of this mural, according to Jose Orozco was representation of a continent characterized by the duality of Indigenous and European Historical Experiences. The mural depicts the cyclical nature of human conflict, self-sacrifice, and regeneration.

West Wing - The Coming and Departure of Quetzalcoatl. I saw depictions of ancient human sacrifice practiced by ancient Mesoamerican Civilizations, the coming of the serpent deity, Quetzalcoatl bestowing his blessings of learning and culture, the creation of the Temple of the Sun and Moon at Teotihuacan, and the departure of omnipotent, Quetzalcoatl.

East Wing - Cortez and The Modern Era - In the East Wing of this ginormous mural Jose Orozco depicts the brutality of the Spanish Conquistadores, peasant struggles, life in an Anglo-American small community, modern human sacrifice, a resurrected Christ, and the importance of education and industry.

My favorite panels of this mural were "The Coming of Quetzalcoatl," "The Departure of Quetzalcoatl," "Cortez and The Cross" (depicts the omnipotence of Cortez and the Catholic Church in Mexico, after the departure of Quetzalcoatl), "Anglo America" (depicts Northern New England in a stereotypical manner; Anglo White Protestant), "Hispano America" (depicts Zapata as the savior of the Mexican Worker from the tyranny of the Porfirio Diaz regime), and "Gods of the Modern World" which focuses on the political tyranny and brutality of the early 1930's. When I first visited Dartmouth University and Hanover, New Hampshire in 1962, I was very surprised to see this mural, because in the 1930's, I associated this part of Northern New England with White Protestant Conservatism. In those days, I was working on my Bachelor's Degree at Lyndon State College (now Vermont State University) about 70 miles from Dartmouth.

This mural was very inspiring, and I appreciate the assistance that I received from listening to the audio tapes of John Watanabe, Dartmouth Professor of Anthropology Meso America Specialist, pertaining to Orozco's mural, as well as reading "Orozco at Dartmouth" published by the Hood Museum of Art in 2012. Admission is free to relish this priceless treasure.





We are continuing writing about Presidents and the Jews, using research by PJ Grisar.

 Benjamin Harrison: Well, he sent a Commission to investigate pogroms in Czarist Russia. But he also went on to credit the "Hebrew" for his industry, but said he feared that immigration would transfer such a multitude that it would keep them from becoming productive citizens. Maybe a "C" grade.

• William McKinley: He was assassinated before he could build much of a record.

• Theodore Roosevelt: "Tough" Jews accompanied him as a Rough Rider and worked for him when he was police Commissioner. As President, he was the first to appoint a Jew to his cabinet. Solomon Strauss was Secretary of Commerce and Labor. Roosevelt was a Zionist, supported Jewish immigration-and owned two menorahs.

 William Taft: He was no friend of Jews. He wrote a letter discussing a jurist's ability to do his job based on his "extreme Judaism." It later became an auction item.

• Woodrow Wilson: Wilson appointed Louis Brandeis to the Supreme Court. He was a champion of Jews and Zionism. Unfortunately, he was racist against black people.

• Warren G. Harding: Harding became a hero to Zionists when he signed the large- Fish Resolution advocating for a Jewish Home in Mandatory Palestine. He died suddenly in 1923. Jews were hoping that he would serve a second term.

• Calvin Coolidge: Of note, He did participate in the laying of a cornerstone at a Jewish Community Center.

• Herbert Hoover: He made the cause of the Jewish state a plank of the Republican platform. He also supported legislation to admit German Jewish children into the country in 1939, and urged his successor, FDR, to do more to help Jewish refugees.

• Franklin Delano Roosevelt: Roosevelt fitted into Jews saying, "It could be worse." They supported him knowing his limitations.

 Harry S. Truman: Truman recognized Israel only 11 minutes after David Ben Gurion announced its Independence. In his writings, Truman was not always a friend to the Jew but had Jewish friends.

• Dwight D. Eisenhower: General Eisenhower liberated the camps, ordering his men to collect testimony and capture everything they could of the Nazis genocidal project on film. He also requested that journalists and members of Congress be flown out to bear witness to what was seen.

• John F. Kennedy: Kennedy was known as a friend of the Jews. When he ran for President and people said that he was too young, he said that he was six years older than Theodore Herzl was when he wrote "The Jewish State." He had Jewish friends and Jews in his cabinet. He once saved Passover by allowing the import of wheat flour from Israel.

• Lyndon B. Johnson: As a Congressperson, Johnson helped Jews flee Europe to the port of Galveston, TX. As President, he was a staunch supporter of Israel.

- Richard Nixon: "The Jews are born spies."
- Gerald Ford: He did work on behalf of Soviet Jewry.

• Jimmy Carter: Some of the ideas in his book, "Palestine: Peace, not Apartheid" caused some Jews to think he was an antisemite. He later apologised to the Jewish community. His ideas today seem mainstream. His peace deal with Sadat and Begin is probably his greatest achievement.

• Ronald Reagan: Fred de Cordova's movie "Bedtime for Bonzo," featuring Ronald Reagan is a classic. As president, Reagan, was a stalwart supporter of Israel.

• George H.W. Bush: Publicly he seemed not doing enough to help Israel accept Jews from the former USSR. As Reagan's Vice President, Bush worked behind the scenes to help Jews escape the Soviet Union, Ethiopia, and Syria.

Bill Clinton: Clinton was known as a friend to the Jews.

 George W. Bush: He surrounded himself with Jewish advisors. He was a hard-liner supporter of Israel. Bush was the 1st President to light a menorah in the White House residence.

• Barack Obama: He was the 1st President to host a White House seder. Donald Trump, Joe Biden: Sorry, with the election this close in time, anything written will seem as political.

Questions About Your 2024 Property Assessment or Exemptions?

Our office mailed over 777,000 TRIM (proposed tax) Notices to Broward County property owners last month. The 2024 Just/Market Values are based on the market data from 2023 as Florida Statutes require our office use January 1st as the date of assessment each year.

The TRIM Notice you received shows your 2024 Just/Market Value, any tax-saving exemptions you are receiving, and the proposed tax amounts as set by the various taxing authorities listed on the notice.

It is important to remember the Property Appraiser's Office does not set or collect taxes.

If you believe you are entitled to a Homestead Exemption or any other exemption not shown on your TRIM Notice, you may still late file for any 2024 exemption until September 18, 2024. The Value Adjustment Board (VAB) is an independent quasi-judicial review board. If you believe your Just/Market Value is not what a buyer would have reasonably paid for your property on January 1, 2024, you should first contact our office. If after speaking with one of our appraisers, you still do not agree, you can file an appeal with the Broward County Value Adjustment Board. If you were denied an exemption, you may also file an appeal with the Value Adjustment Board challenging this denial. The absolute deadline for Value Adjustment Board petitions is September 18, 2024. 

Difficult Personalities and How to Deal With Them

We all know them. A co-worker, job supervisor, neighbor, relative, friend or associate with a difficult personality who has deeply annoyed you or even hurt you. Dealing with difficult personalities is a challenge and can take a toll on your mental and physical wellbeing.

What is a difficult personality? "A personality is

difficult when the individual does not honor and engage in the usual rules and social conventions taught by society for fairness and mutual respect. Difficult personalities can take many forms, including engaging in a passiveaggressive communication style, being overtly hostile or verbally aggressive, having a bad temper, trying to split allegiances and loyalties of those around them, feeling threatened when someone seems too competent or strong, and getting defensive or even combative when someone holds them accountable for inappropriate behavior." (Psychology Today, posted 5/26/2020). In severe cases, some difficult people may have a personality disorder, but most do not.

How can you tell that you're dealing with someone with a difficult personality and not someone who is just having a bad day or going through stressful life circumstances?

Here are some warning signs: focusing only on themselves; unable to understand and share another person's feelings, thoughts and experiences; getting offended or angry frequently and easily; lashing out when irritated; feeling misunderstood; being a bad listener and ignoring your opinion; constantly judging and criticizing others; complaining about everything; using emotional blackmail (sulking, crying, shaming, guilt-tripping, threatening, becoming cold) to manipulate you into doing what they want. People with difficult personalities make themselves the center of drama or attention. They come across as stubborn and arrogant and seem unable to empathize with others.

You may have tried to deal with difficult people by avoiding them or by trying to ignore their behaviors. You might hope they will move out of the neighborhood, change jobs, skip the family reunion, or just leave you in peace. But there are better strategies than avoidance and hope. Understanding the types of difficult people you encounter can help indicate ways of effectively communicating and interacting with them. This article will focus on "Negative People." Subsequent articles will discuss other difficult personalities as well as personality disorders.

Negative People

We all have bad days. If we are sad or depressed, we might complain, criticize, or make sarcastic, nasty comments. We have all done it from time to time. However, when the frequency and intensity of this kind of negativity becomes a personality pattern, it can become a real problem for us and others.

Negative people will routinely be pessimistic, criticize, find fault, denigrate, and disparage others. While friendly people might give constructive criticism or feedback with the intent of helping someone improve, negative people will come across as judgmental. Whether consciously or subconsciously, their intent is to lift themselves up by putting others down.

Negative people are exhausting and alienate others. They find it hard to develop good relationships and maintain them over the long term. They

can be hurtful to individuals and destructive to an organization, workplace, or a community. Negative people are hypercritical and use mistakes and vulnerabilities to attack and hurt others in the present or in the future. Since what they do to others, they are likely to do to us, we often feel unsafe around them. Negativity can be contagious and can lead others to behave that way.

Tactics Negative People Use

Name, Shame, and Blame: Negative people name-call, put down, insult, or use derogatory terms. Overtly or subtly, they try to make others feel ashamed of innocent mistakes. They never take responsibility and instead blame others—even someone close—for anything that goes wrong in their life. Their relationships tend to be both unstable and intense.

Label, Gossip and Exaggerate: A negative person will turn a simple mistake into a generalization. If you are late for work one morning, they will label you as lazy or someone who is always late. Negative people present suspicions as conclusions and engage in gossip and spread rumors, even if the rumors are unconfirmed. They exaggerate bad news to make it more dramatic and draw attention to themselves. They cannot be trusted to keep a secret or act in a loyal fashion towards others.

Complain and Whine: Negative people complain all the time, even about trivial things. They find any unpleasant or annoying aspect of any situation and focus on that, and then relentlessly communicate their unhappiness and intolerance.

Flaw Finding: If there is an imperfection or an error, negative people will find it and focus on it, while ignoring, denying, or excluding everything else that is good or positive. In a relationship, if the significant other makes a mistake or has an oversight, negative people will laser-focus on it to the exclusion of the many loving things that the other has done. They are prone to sudden and dramatic shifts in their view of others, quickly changing from idealizing someone to seeing them as horrible and cruel. Finding fault in others makes them feel superior.

Playing the Victim: Negative people portray themselves as victims and believe that their life is more difficult than everyone else's. Some of the manipulative techniques they use to get what they want include: inflicting guilt by portraying themselves as vulnerable and wounded to manipulate others into bending rules and crossing boundaries on their favor; evading accountability by using past hardships to excuse transgressions or misconduct in the present; shifting blame by immediately becoming defensive when confronted with wrongdoing. They play the victim and accuse the other person of being unfair, mean, and abusive.

Strategies for Deal with Another's Negativity

Be calm. When the person is expressing the negativity in an agitated, dramatic way, stay calm. Usually, they use exaggerated body language such as expansive arm movements and exaggerated facial gestures. Counteract their dramatization by keeping your own body movements to a minimum.

Deescalate their emotions. Don't reinforce the negativity. Respond with short neutral words like "really?" "oh?" or "hmm" and then change the topic. Walk away, without being offensive. Acknowledge the person politely, smile and wish them a good day.

Try not to be alone with them. Dilute their influence with other people's company. Counterbalance every negative with a positive in conversation and action. When they complain about someone, you can reply with "Perhaps, but none of us is perfect."

Distract them. New hobbies or tasks can redirect their attention. Diversions can especially help the elderly whose negativity may stem from loneliness, chronic pain, disabilities, and other health issues.

Strategies for Dealing with Your Own Negativity

Identify your own pattern. It's easier to see negative personality traits in others than in ourselves. Be frank with yourself.

Do a reality check. Ask someone close to you "Do you think I behave negatively?"

Accept feedback. Be receptive when people who are close to you point out your negativity about people or things in your life.

Augment positivity. Make a resolution to praise rather than disparage. Look for assets rather than liabilities.

We are all imperfect people living in an imperfect world. We can't always change our circumstances, but we can change our attitudes towards them. As we try to improve ourselves and the world around us, it is helpful to keep in mind that kindness and positivity can be as contagious as meanness and negativity. If we treat others' shortcomings and imperfections as we would like others to treat our own, we can all help each other have more peaceful and happy lives.





Respect Thy Neighbor By Hillel Cohen, DrPH, MPH keeping the peace in election season

"Love Thy Neighbor" is an admirable thought, but not always easy to achieve. "Respect Thy Neighbor" is a lot easier and absolutely essential for our community to be the peaceful, friendly place we want it to be, especially in election season. Local and national elections are coming up soon. The country is sharply divided on many issues. Political ads, social media posts and talking heads on TV and radio are getting louder and harsher. It's serious business and many of us are passionately for "our side" or against "the other side." For our community, the challenge is to not let passionate differences turn neighbors into "enemies" or "adversaries."

Despite any political differences, as residents and neighbors in Wynmoor we have many common interests. Being united can make us stronger so we can push back Turnpike Expansion, the spread of Mount Trashmore, and out-of-control insurance premiums. When there's a hurricane, or when someone has a health emergency, helping each other as neighbors improves our chances of getting through the crises. It's for this reason that Wynmoor's long-standing rule of NO ELECTIONEERING OF ANY KIND ON WYNMOOR GROUNDS is so important. "Electioneering" means actions supporting or advertising a candidate running for office. There are two kinds. "Active electioneering" includes going door to door with campaign materials or handing out flyers. "Passive electioneering" includes displaying signs, flags, hats, t-shirts or any other material with a candidate's name or picture or encouraging support for a candidate. Electioneering of any kind is not allowed on Wynmoor grounds.

When I first saw the no electioneering provisions in our condo documents, I thought these were onerous, unreasonable restrictions. Having spent decades in political activity, I thought how dare they tell me I can't put up a sign or wear a button or hat for my favorite candidates. But over time, I became friends with neighbors who I would later find out had political views completely opposite mine. Had we started off by flaunting our respective views, we would have exclusively focused on our political differences and overlooked what we had in common. We would have seen each other as political opponents rather than as good neighbors.

It reminded me of family Thanksgiving Day gatherings long ago. Loved ones who we hadn't seen in a year would crowd into our small space with warm greetings and hugs. Dinner talk would be pleasant with stories and old jokes until the conversation drifted to political issues. Before long, smiles disappeared, replaced by furrowed eyebrows, and clenched jaws, while voices got louder and harsher. By dessert, some would no longer be on speaking terms and would leave with a huff, not to mention indigestion. As months went by, the anger and bitterness faded, and the next gathering would again start on a high note until it again devolved into rancor. Eventually, we learned that if we kept the conversation to politically neutral topics, we could actually enjoy each others' company.

Notably, despite years of arguments, no one ever changed anyone else's mind. Sure, some would change their opinions over time, but not due to arguments, but because life experiences and attitudes changed. What was the point of the arguments?

This is not to say that neighbors can't have a friendly discussion on controversial issues. But the trappings of electioneering are not conversations. Nor do they convince anybody of anything. Rather, they are ways of saying that's "my team" and if you're not on my team, to hell with you. Not long ago, someone wearing a candidate's t-shirt at the main pool prompted a remark that then became a shouting match and almost became a fistfight. Do we really need that kind of stress? The Wynmoor rules against electioneering help keep our community peaceful.

I've heard some say that this rule violates their First Amendment rights to say or display anything they want. Not true. Everyone has the absolute right to electioneer on the public streets outside Wynmoor grounds. As a private community association, we have the right to have rules of conduct for the betterment of the community. According to the rules, there are times and places - specifically and exclusively the political club meetings - where electioneering is allowed.

We are a self-governing community with elected boards of directors, both in each Village and in the Wynmoor Community Council. We have lots of rules here. Some are for safety. Some are for security. Some are to preserve the appearance or the property values, and so on. Of course, not everyone likes every rule. I for one, think the rule against wearing shorts to the Theatre shows is silly. But it's the rule, and if I'm going to respect my neighbors and the community as a whole, I have to respect that rule too-even if I don't agree with it.

Almost all in Wynmoor abide by the rule against electioneering, but not all are aware of it. When I mentioned it to some who were displaying their candidate's hat, they said they didn't know the rule, but would abide even if they disagreed. Only one individual, when told, responded with "stick the rules up your a**." That type of nasty belligerence was a sign to me that his main goal was not to convince anyone to vote for his candidate but to give a middle finger to and irritate and stress out those who had opposite views. Good neighbors just don't do that. As the election draws closer, summer temperatures will cool off, but passions and tempers will undoubtedly heat up. Let's help keep Wynmoor a safe, peaceful, and friendly community by respecting our neighbors and respecting the rules-including "no electioneering of any kind on Wynmoor grounds."





ASK DR. JOY By Joy Berke Sanchez Ph.D.



The Mind-Body Connection For those of you who are registered to come to my class for the first time on September 11th, please make sure you have read this article. Thank you. Do any of the following sound like you? It runs in the family. It's flu season again. I was just on a plane (or in a crowd) that's why I have a cold. God uses disease to teach us something. It's 'going around'. Disease builds character.

When you reach a certain age, bodies just start falling apart. I can probably go on and on with this but you get the idea. See if you have some of your own pet ideas that I didn't think to put on my list.

It's not only your beliefs and attitudes that have an effect on your health. Your physician's beliefs also matter. Dr. Larry Dossey, who writes extensively about this, says that your doctor can influence you and your outcomes in both positive and negative ways. He says that physicians can exert powerful effects through their beliefs. If they strongly favor a certain medication or therapy and talk up the effects in a cheerleader manner a patient will "catch" their enthusiasm and even a placebo will work. On the other hand, Dr. Dossey speaks of a patient of another doctor who was seriously ill and wrote to him. In part, this is what she wrote. "I began to realize that my doctor doesn't believe I'm going to live. It takes me two weeks to recover from a visit to him. He leaves me depressed and feeling sicker. After a while I begin to feel more positive and physically healthier and then the cycle begins again when it's time for my next appointment. Why do I feel like my own physician is killing me?" Why indeed??

One book that we use in my class is Your Mind Can Heal Your Body by Dr. David Hamilton. This book talks about placebos, nocebos, visualizations and a bunch of other techniques. Highly recommended. You can see Dr. Hamilton on the documentary Heal along with a lot of other mind-body healers. Also, highly recommended.

As I've mentioned in previous articles, thoughts are vibrations that go out into the universe and attract like thoughts and then physical manifestations to themselves. We rendezvous with these thoughts and people constantly pick up their vibrations as they pick up ours. Especially if we believe that the person, like your physician, has the credibility to know the 'truth'. We then believe it and our own thoughts can create our health or illness.

There is a book out by Dr. Bruce Lipton in which he says that our thoughts can actually change our DNA. How about that? I find that remarkable and it should eliminate the 'it runs in the family' excuse.

We all know and agree that stress and constant negativity and negative expectations can change our health as can depression and anger. But how about opposite feelings? Can extreme positivity and joy also affect your health? Of course it can. Along with feelings of peace, love and serenity. Those will lead to a sense of well-being and your body will get the message and transform itself and manifest that well-being physically.

When Dr. Dean Ornish was all the rage, maybe in the 80s and 90s, he had a three-step program for people with heart disease. The first step was to become a whole, unprocessed food vegan, the second was mild-moderate exercise and the third, which to me summed it all up, was to meditate and share in a support group that stressed wellness rather than regurgitation of fears and complaints. All his participating patients improved but the ones who consistently meditated and attended group meetings did remarkably better.

I can write so much more on this subject especially the power of prayer, which I will briefly touch on here. There was a study done regarding in vitro fertizization where the success rate was about 20% on the first attempt. A group of pray-ers got together and anonymously prayed for the women getting the procedure. The patients were not told about this at all and had no idea they were being prayed for. So what happened? The success rate for the women who were prayed for by strangers and didn't even know it, jumped to over 50%. So what do we define prayer as? The act of praying is actually the clear focus of intentional thoughts with the expectance of a favorable outcome through tapping into a power greater than we are. That power can take the form of a religious icon or the vibrations or quantum energy of the universe. However you define it, use it..

Health is our natural state and through negative beliefs, our own and those we have adopted and bought into, we add or attach disease into our being. Our goal is to eliminate, to the best of our current ability, these add-ons and picture ourselves in our natural state of wellness. It's all mind work. We have a powerful tool at our disposal if we just learn to channel and direct it. It takes commitment and practice. Good luck with this. It gets easier and is very effective.










The Latecomer By Jean Hanff Korelitz






