



Hanukkah lasts for eight days. It commemorates the rededication of the Temple in Jerusalem after it was defiled by the Seleucids in 164 BCE and is one of the happiest Jewish holidays of the year.

Interestingly enough, it is also one of the most celebrated holidays. It is considered a minor holiday, but to many Jews it is the most important one of the year. It is not mentioned in the Torah and does not have any restrictions or very minimal ones. Almost 3/4 of all Jews in the world celebrate this holiday.

Why isn't Hanukkah in the Torah? The answer is simple. The events took place centuries after the Torah was written. Hanukkah is found in the Apocrypha, and in the story of First and Second Maccabees.

This story begins in 163 B.C.E. Antiochus forces the Jews to assimilate into Hellenistic Greek culture and makes it a capital offence to observe Judaism. Mattathias and his five sons lead a revolt against the oppressive monarch. After a year, Mattathias is killed in battle and Judah takes over as leader of



the Maccabees. In 164 BCE, Jewish troops captured Jerusalem. They find the temple in terrible condition. A little bit of oil lasted for eight days. Two miracles have taken place. The first is the victory of the Maccabees and the second is the oil lasting for eight days.

Over the years either one of the

miracles has been the focus. Modern Jews celebrate both. In Hanukkah, we are celebrating divine miracles God performed for our ancestors, courageous human action, and the miraculous possibilities that can result from the sacred partnership each one of us has with God.

Hanukkah tells us to fight back and bring light to the world. In this era of rising antisemitism this is a lesson we must remember. Its message is one of hope.

How do you spell Hanukkah? So far, I have found 27 different ways. All are correct, as it is a transliteration of the Hebrew.

Hanukkah greetings follow the format of greetings for other Jewish holidays. Hanukkah Sameach (Happy Hanukkah), Chag Sameach (Happy Holiday), and Chag Urim Sameach (Happy Festival of Lights).

Hanukkah is not the Jewish Christmas. Christmas celebrates the birth of Jesus, while Hanukkah celebrates the victory of the Maccabees over the Greeks and the miracle of the oil. What they do have in common are family gatherings, some gift giving, charity, food, and the hope for renewal.

Food cooked in oil are traditional in all branches of Judaism. There are latkes (potato pancakes), sufganiyot (donuts or spanj) and an overload of sweets.

The Hanukkah menorah, or hanukkiah, is an eight branched candle holder with a ninth candle holder to hold the "helper" candle called a shamash. It is lit immediately after sundown each night except for Shabbat, when it is lit before the shabbat candles. A traditional hanukkiah has eight level candle holders and the shamash is a bit higher. Candles are placed in the holder from right to left and lit from left to right. It is usual to place the hanukkiah where it can be seen from the outside.

The blessings: Say the following after the shamash is lit but before it is used to light the other candles.

- 1. Baruch Atah Adonai Eloheinu Melech haolam asher kideshanu bemitzvotav vetzivanu lhadlik ner Hanukkah. Blessed are you, God, ruler of the universe, who has sanctified us with your commandments and commanded us to kindle the Hanukkah lights.
- 2. Baruch Atah Adonai Eloheinu Melech haolam sheasa nisam loavoteno bayamin hahem bazman hazeh. Blessed are you, God, Ruler of the universe, who performed miracles for our ancestors in those days, at this time.
 - 3. On the first night, the shehecheyanu is said.

May the lights of Hanukkah and Christmas bring us all joy and peace. May we always remember what unites us as human beings. We are always one.

Holiday Guide to Crime Prevention



It's that time of the year again! Christmas trees! Menorahs! Family get-togethers!

Criminals love this time of year too because it provides more opportunities for scams, frauds, and thievery.

Here is a guide to making sure any scammers don't ruin your holiday:

If you're leaving town-

- 1) Lock everything. Leave some lights on. If you can, leave a car in the driveway. Home burglars often select targets based solely on the fact that there's no car in the driveway or parked in the garage.
- 2) Trim the hedges. Pick up around the outside. Don't leave the burglars any hiding places.
- 3) Pick up your spare key. If you keep it under the welcome mat or the potted plant near your front door, please pick it up. The bad guys know exactly where to look.
- 4) Have your neighbors pick up your mail. If you leave a week's worth of mail in your box, you might as well just put up a "burglars welcome" sign in your driveway.
- 5) Sign up for our Vacation Watch, which is where an officer will visit your property on a regular basis while you're away and send you an email or text message that they checked it. Visit www.coconutcreek.net/vacationwatch for more information.

If you're staying home-

1) Get into the habit of locking your car doors at night before you go to

- bed. Over half of all our vehicle burglary cases involve either unlocked car doors or no sign of forced entry.
- 2) Lock everything up when you go for a walk, run, or go out to walk the dog. Again, it's just a good habit to get into.
- 3) Shut your garage door. We have a lot of things stolen from open garage areas, not only this time of year but all times of the year.
- 4) Track your package deliveries to make sure you are home. If you're not at home, try having them delivered to work or tell your neighbor to pick them up off your front doorstep. We typically see an increase in porch pirates this time of year.

If you're out shopping-

- 1) Don't leave your purse or wallet laying around. Always keep it on you.
 - 2) Park in well-lit areas.
- 3) Get into the habit of having your keys in your hand when you approach your car. It streamlines the process of getting in and can be used as an improvised weapon if you really get in a pinch.
- 4) Don't bury your face in your phone when you're walking to and from your car into or out of the shopping mall or store. You need to always be situationally aware and be in tune with your surroundings.
- 5) If you're going from shopping mall to shopping mall, hide all your packages before you get to your next destination. Some thieves just sit in parking lots and watch to see what people hide before they go in.
- 6) Always lock your car and never leave anything the bad guys might want to steal in plain view.

All these tips will take some of the stress out of this holiday season.

2025 HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION

All qualified Florida residents are eligible to receive a Homestead Exemption on their homes, condominiums, co-op apartments, and certain mobile home lots. To qualify for Homestead Exemption, you must own and make the property your permanent residence on January 1 of the year for which you are applying for this valuable exemption. Pursuant to Florida law, all assessments and exemptions are based upon the status of the property on January 1. If you acquired the property as your permanent residence in 2024 and have not applied for Homestead Exemption, you can apply for 2025 exemptions at any time - there is no need to wait until 2025 to file your exemption application. You can easily apply online at https://web.bcpa.net/ bcpaclient/#/HomesteadExemption

The timely deadline to file for all 2025 exemptions is March 3, 2025. You must make the property your permanent residence by January 1, 2025 to qualify; however, you have until March 3 to timely file your application with the our office. The late filing deadline for all 2025 exemptions is September 17, 2025.

Once approved, your Homestead Exemption automatically renews each year provided there is no change in the ownership or use of the property. If you have already applied and been approved for Homestead Exemption at your current property, you do not need to reapply for this exemption. You will receive a Homestead Exemption renewal card next month to keep for your records.

The Many Reasons to Avoid Probate

You have heard that Probate is something to avoid; however, unless you have been through it, you may not understand why. Here are some basic facts about probate in Florida:

1. Full Probate (assets over \$75,000 or under \$75,000 with creditors) takes at least six months to a year or longer. During that time, the assets being probated are tied up. If your heirs want to sell your home in probate, they must go through a formal process. This includes filing a Petition to administer the Estate. If successful, the Judge of the Probate Court will sign an Order called Letters of Administration. This could take one to three months.



The next step is Notice to Creditors published in a newspaper. This must be done even if there are no creditors. Creditors have 90 days from the date of first publication to file a claim against the Estate. Nothing can be done regarding distribution of the assets until after the ninety days.

A tax id number from the IRS must be obtained for the Estate. Once the Personal Representative (Executor) obtains the Letters of Administration and the tax id number, an Estate account can be opened to transfer any funds from an account or future proceeds from the sale of a home or other real estate. If real estate is involved, a court order is generally necessary to allow the closing and another court order may be necessary to distribute proceeds.

A formal Inventory must be filed listing exact date of death values of all assets being probated.

A formal accounting may be necessary if all beneficiaries do not agree to waive it.

Once all distributions are made, the Estate cannot be closed without another court order.

If an estate asset is discovered after the Personal Representative has been discharged by the court, the Estate must be reopened and more formalities

must be followed.

- 2. The attorney's fees can be quite high, depending on the value of the Estate. Florida law authorizes a 3% fee on the first million dollars, and a sliding percentage thereafter. The Personal Representative can negotiate with the lawyer for a lower fee. If the Estate is valued at \$700,000 and the fee is reduced from 3% to 2%, that is still a \$14,000 fee, plus about \$1,000 in court costs for filing fees, publication in the newspaper, etc. An attorney can also charge an hourly rate, but this could easily exceed the 3%, particularly on smaller estates.
- 3. The Personal Representative will probably need to pay money out of pocket for

initial costs and a Retainer for the attorney, plus funeral bills if not already pre-paid. In addition, if real estate is involved, the Personal Representative may have to pay taxes, utilities, maintenance, mortgage payments etc. until access to Estate funds is authorized. The Personal Representatives will reimburse themselves at that time, but it could cause hardship if personal funds are limited.

4. All of the above is stressful and time consuming for the Personal Representative. Although a fee is allowed, this could be an issue if family members or other beneficiaries object.

That is just a brief summary of why it is so crucial to have proper and complete estate planning with a lawyer to be sure that ALL assets avoid probate. Please refer to many of my other articles for practical tips on avoiding probate.



ASK DR. JOY

EMOTIONAL CURRENCY



This month's article is based on a couple of different excerpts from previous ones and my 2010 book on narcissism. It's on what I call emotional currency or EC.

Everyone has ways in which they want to 'get paid' emotionally or intimately. These are the behaviors, gestures, etc. that lead to a person feeling loved, valued, appreciated and a host of other psychological necessities. Different people use different currencies to give and receive closeness

and impart feelings of caring and love.

For example, service. Both men and women use service to show their love. I don't want to be sexist and these examples are meant to be merely illustrative. A woman may pick up her husband's shirts at the cleaner's and he may wash her car. Of course, these behaviors can be reversed (have to be very careful these days not to offend anyone). If both people view service in the same way, they both will feel loved and cared for when these things are done for them. However, if one of them just regards doing these things as part of running a household, that person will not feel 'paid' by the gesture. Oftentimes the other will point this out and say he or she was met with a mere 'thanks' because the partner on the receiving end thought it was not particularly special.

Another example is money or gifts. Sometimes one partner believes that buying an extravagant gift is a wonderful way of showing love. If the person on the receiving end thinks the same way, then both partners will feel loved and appreciated and their emotional banks will have a deposit. If, however, you have one person believing that gifts are a show of love and the other thinking that picking up the dry cleaning is, we're going to have two unfulfilled people. The one who didn't receive the gift and the one whose trip to the cleaners was not appreciated. Neither partner here is going to feel emotionally paid.

One very important difference is in what constitutes emotional intimacy. I will use myself as an example. To me, closeness comes from intimate conversation. These conversations can be intellectual as well as emotionally revealing. They come from sharing ideas, philosophies, theories, experiences and opinions as well as intimate and personal feelings. This would be true

for me in any relationship whether with friends, my daughters, spouse, etc. This was also true when I ran groups and watched people blossom because they were able to share their deepest selves and their ideas and learn to accept the revelations of others. For me, this is what it means to be 'in relationship' with another person and this is what fosters intimacy and caring for another. When I don't have that I can only reach a certain level of relationship which may be fine in casual friendships and acquaintanceships but those relations cannot and will not deepen. Of course, I also tend to pay in that same currency and although I can and do pay in all forms of emotional currency, they are not primary for me.

Another important currency is time. Some people require spending a great deal of time with the other and some need much less. If you believe that the amount of time spent together should be a primary factor of the relationship, being with someone with many other interests who doesn't't have the same time requirements you do will make you both unhappy. You will see time spent doing other things as a rejection of you and the other will find your demands suffocating and neither of you will be filling your emotional bank.

Time spent together is definitely an important factor in relationships. It is difficult to feel loved and cared for when the person you want to be with hasn't the time to spend with you. The important thing to look at here is desire. If the other person has a time-consuming job or other necessary demands but you know you are valued and the desire to spend the time with you is there, it is quite different than being with someone who is fitting you in to a whimsical schedule, seeing you when he/she feels like it or when it is convenient. Trying to receive something from someone who is unable to give it is a major effort in frustration and futility for both people involved.

Another example and method of payment is paying with physical affection and/or compliments. This comes naturally to some people and is very difficult for others both to give and to receive. Again, if the balance of desire and need does not match you will be in for a rough ride.

To be paid in your own currency is to experience yourself as loved, valuable, important, cared for, psychologically visible and a real part of a relationship. To be paid in a way that is less important to you or even in a way you might not even notice leads to feeling invisible as your deepest self and when you feel invisible you cannot feel loved and cared for. Imagine having your emotional currency bank depleted and then imagine it overflowing. Quite a difference.

Due to space constraints I have shortened this extensively but hopefully you got the idea and can come up with your own currencies and listen to the important people in your life about theirs.



book kept me company on afternoon walks, and I listened three times to the concluding chapters.


The Shoemaker's Wife

The author was inspired by the story of her grandparents' lives, and her love of their world shows in the meticulous research and loving descriptions. Characters ring true, though by the end of the book I was slightly exhausted by the sheer scope of the story. This was her family; perhaps she had difficulty leaving anything out.







What You Need To Know About Cataracts

(NAPSI)—By age 80, most people either have cataracts or have had cataract surgery. That's because most cataracts are the result of natural aging. You may not notice that you have a cataract at first. But over time, they can make your vision blurry or hazy, colors fade, you can't see well at night, or you may see double images. The good news is that cataract surgery can restore your sight. With a high success rate of more than 90 percent, cataract surgery enables people to see better after their cataract is removed.

Here are the top six things ophthalmologists—physicians who specialize in medical and surgical eye care—want you to know about cataracts:

1. Cataracts can be removed with surgery. Surgery is the only way to cure cataracts. Early

on, you may be able to cope with reduced vision from cataracts by using brighter lights, wearing anti-glare sunglasses, or using magnifying lenses for reading. But if cataracts start getting in the way of everyday activities such as reading, driving, or watching TV, an ophthalmologist will need to remove the clouded natural lens and replace it with an artificial lens, also called an intraocular lens (or IOL), to correct blurry vision.

2. You can slow development of early cataracts. You can take steps to protect your eyes from cataracts. Using 100% UV blocking sunglasses, quitting smoking, maintaining control over high blood sugar, and eating a healthy diet can help prevent cataracts.

3. People with diabetes are more likely to get cataracts. Natural aging is the

most common cause of cataracts, but some people are at higher risk for cataracts than others. People who have diabetes with high blood sugar levels can get cataracts quicker and at a younger age than those with normal blood sugar levels. Improving glucose levels may help delay cataracts.


4. Eye color affects your risk of developing cataracts. Studies show that people with dark brown eyes have a higher risk of developing cataracts than people with lighter eyes. However, UV light is a known contributor to cataract development no matter what color your eyes are. Wearing sunglasses whenever outdoors is recommended for everyone.

5. Treating cataracts may decrease your risk of dementia. Though the link between

eye health and dementia is unclear, recent studies suggest people who had cataract surgery were 30 percent less likely to develop dementia.

6. You may eventually need a follow-up procedure. Some people will again develop hazy vision years after cataract surgery. This is usually because the lens capsule has become cloudy. The capsule is the part of your eye that holds the IOL in place. Your ophthalmologist can use a laser to open the cloudy capsule and restore clear vision, a procedure called a capsulotomy.

Regular eye exams are important to maintaining your best vision, even after cataract surgery. The American Academy of Ophthalmology recommends scheduling a visit to the ophthalmologist every year after cataract surgery if you're older than 65, or every two years if under 65.



Our Amazing Self-Healing Ability

One of the primary goals of Acupuncture, and many other forms of medicine including Western pharmacological-based medicine, is to create an environment in our bodies

conducive to the expression of our own self-healing ability. Antibiotics, for example, do not heal us from bacterial infection. They are used instead to reduce to bacterial load in our bodies so that our primary innate healing mechanism, our immune system, can take over and do the actual work. But there are other, less obvious healing mechanisms which are constantly operating to repair our bodies and keep us healthy, if not immediately, then certainly over time.

I have always been physically active. As a "hyper-active" child I was either running, swimming, cycling or wrestling. As an adult I added yoga and while living in New Orleans in the 1980's I became involved in distance running, specifically 10K (6.2 miles) races. These were grand events in New Orleans, attracting professional runners form all over the world as well as wannabes like myself. The race would start in the historic French Quarter and proceed down Prytania Avenue through the Garden District with jazz bands playing along the way to support the runners. The event would conclude along St. Charles Avenue in majestic Auduban Park with a Mardi-Gras style party of music, food, beer, dancing and of course, the commemorative T-shirt.

It was during a training run preparing for one of these "Crescent City Classics" as they were called, that I fell into a pothole in the street, breaking a small bone in my right foot, and spraining all the lateral ligaments. I was effectively crippled and never ran another race. It was 8 weeks until I was able to remove the cast. Following rehab, I was still in pain. Every step was painful. I was told I would just have to learn to live with it.

Fast forward 10 years and I was still in pain. I had completed my

acupuncture training and had been treated numerous times by the best teachers my school had to offer as well as other practicing acupuncturists and I was still in pain.

Then I had a dream. In this dream I was back in acupuncture school. I recognized all my classmates sitting around me and the school was hosting 3 Chinese acupuncturists who were renown for their skills. They asked for a volunteer and I did. I was invited to the front of the classroom and sat on a treatment table. I pointed to my right foot and described precisely where it hurt. For the next several minutes the three discussed and argued (in Chinese) about points to be used for more treatment. After much haggling they decided or 4 acupuncture points, all local, and all very nearly (but not quite) at the exact same spots I have been needled dozens of times with no improvement. I sat there for some minutes while they manipulated the needles which were then removed and I returned to my seat. That was the dream.

It was some time the next day that I realized my foot and ankle pain were gone. GONE!! And it's been gone ever since. How do I explain this? Well, in acupuncture theory it is said that "Qi (energy) follows thought" and that "Qi is the leader of blood." In acupuncture terms, pain is defined as the "stagnation or blockage of qi and blood." So, it follows that to eliminate pain, the goal is the promote the free flow of qi (energy) and blood. And if qi actually does follow thought, then it stands to reason we can facilitate qi (and blood flow) by intention and will. I do not know what supportive factors may have been operative the night of that dream other than the long-standing desire and intention for my foot pain to be gone and the almost daily visualization of healing warmth flowing through my foot.

At the Xican-aox. Body Temporary Exhibit, I saw works of Art that depicted the Chicano Life Experience in California. Albiet, I saw impressive works by Gabriela Munoz "Brown on Brown-Lorena," portrait made using breast milk, Mexican Earth on handmade paper from yucca and saguaro and immigrant's clothing, Julia Landois "Don't Explain," a video depicting a nude woman on a pedestal menstruating, and John Valadez "Chicana," Pencil on Rag Paper. Many of the works of Art at this exhibit emphasized Women's Rights and how Mexican Americans have been discriminated against in California.




