Year Ends With Several Scam Alerts For Coconut Creek

I wish I could say it ended better.

We issued several Scam Alerts on our social media pages before the close of 2024. You can find these on our Facebook page, Instagram account, or by following us on Nextdoor. If social media is just not your thing, you can periodically check our website for Scam Alerts. It's www.coconutcreek.net/pd.

In case you missed it, here are the alerts we issued since my last column:

The Bank Representative Phone Scam is the basis for this Coconut

The Bank Representative Phone Scam is the basis for this Coconut Creek Police Department Scam Alert. A Coconut Creek man recently contacted us after someone posing as a representative from his bank called him unexpectedly and told him there was significant fraud going on with his account. This was news to the victim because he hadn't noticed anything out of the ordinary. The scammer kept him talking, gaining valuable information such as his account login and password. The fraudster used that information to transfer money out of the victim's account. Luckily, the bank caught it in time before dispersing the funds. Remember that no one from your bank would ever call you out of the blue for any reason. If you get a similar phone call, just hang up.

The Medicare Scam is the reason for this Coconut Creek Police Department Scam Alert. A woman recently called us after she had given her full name, date of birth, address, and social security number to someone posing as a Medicare representative on the phone. The scammer told her they were changing cards and needed that information to facilitate the transition. Right after she did it, the woman didn't feel right about it, called

Medicare, and learned it was a scam. Remember that no one from Medicare would ever call you asking for any information. If you get a similar phone call, just hang up.

Seniors and phone scams are the basis for this Coconut Creek Police Department Scam Alert. While anyone, of any age, is susceptible to falling for a phone scam, the fraudsters often target seniors in particular. This happened recently to 79-year-old man here in Coconut Creek. A scammer called him posing as a representative from Best Buy. The scammer said he owed him a \$199 fee and proceeded to talk the victim into giving him access to his computer. The scammer then transferred a large amount of money out of the victim's bank account and into one he controlled. Always remember that no one representing any company would ever call you about an unpaid bill or fee. It's a scam. So just hang up.

The Lending Club Scam is the basis for this Coconut Creek Police Department Scam Alert. The Lending Club is a financial services corporation and A+-rated by the Better Business Bureau. However, like many other loan companies, the scammers like to impersonate Lending Club representatives over the phone. This happened to a Coconut Creek man recently. A fraudster called him pretending to be from the Lending Club. He offered a great "rate" on a loan, along with other benefits. Of course, none of it was true. The scammer had the victim go to the store and buy gift cards and give him all the numbers on the back. The bad guys will usually claim this helps "pay fees" or expedite the process. As Lending Club explains on its website, it would never call or email you asking to do anything of the sort. If you get a similar phone call, just hang up.

-Each morning upon waking, before opening your eyes, stretch like a cat. After a few minutes of stretching, with eyes still closed, begin to laugh. Laugh for five minutes. At first you may need to force it a little, but soon the sound of your attempt will cause genuine laughter! It will change the whole nature of your day.

-Gather with friends for the sole purpose of telling jokes. Laughing together is a great way to develop camaraderie, make new memories and have a great time.

-Watch every comedy show (sitcoms, late night, funny movies) to tickle that Clown Chakra of yours!

-Remember to breathe and smile throughout the day.

How can you hold onto stress and anxiety when you don't take things so seriously?

With laughter, you begin to see the humor in everything; in your disappointments, your pain, and even in yourself! Laughter can give you a new perspective. With laughter, your relationships can improve, your health can improve, and you can find peace of mind.

Is Your Health Worth More Than Garbage?



Mount Trashmore is the 210 foot-tall landfill mountain alongside Wiles Road, between Powerline and the Turnpike. You can see it, and sometimes smell it, from miles away. Waste Management (WM) is the \$91 BILLION national corporation that owns and operates the Monarch Hill Landfill known as Mt. Trashmore. WM wants to increase its profits by expanding Mt. Trashmore, seriously hurting our air and water quality. In other words, they want to increase their profits at the expense of our health. The corporation has asked the Broward County Commission to allow them to expand the landfill area by 24 acres and to let it grow to 325 feet tall –taller than the Statue of Liberty. Whether they can get away with it will depend on whether we can successfully fight back.

At times the odor from the landfill, even at its current size, can be pretty bad. And like all landfills, this one leaks methane into the air which contributes to global warming. But an even more immediate problem is that decomposing garbage and construction debris produces toxic liquids inside the mountain that seep down and leach into the water table and pollute the soil. Polluted soil can become airborne as toxic dust, a direct health threat, because it contaminates our air and falls anywhere the wind takes it. A contaminated water table can wind up in our drinking water, another direct health threat. To prevent this, landfills are supposed to have a lining underneath called a barrier, but the barrier for Mt. Trashmore is almost 60 years old and is likely deteriorating. The barrier that was installed decades ago would violate today's regulation standards. It is only allowed because of "grandfathering" since it was built before modern regulations were put in place. Much of the proposed expanded 24 acres would not be covered even by the old barrier. And the added millions of tons of weight of an additional 100 feet of garbage and refuse would greatly increase the amount of toxic liquids that will permeate the existing inadequate and deteriorating barrier. In short, the bad situation for our health of the current landfill will be made much worse by the expansion.

Waste Management argues that the refuse "has to go somewhere." In fact, most of the garbage collected from Coconut Creek and Deerfield Beach already goes somewhere else—a few hours north in a much less populated area. WM wants the expansion mostly for demolition and construction debris. They argue that transporting waste to Okeechobee or elsewhere would cost more and lead to higher prices. Supposedly, they just want to save the consumer money. That argument is the same false argument corporations use when they oppose raising wages supposedly to keep prices down. Frankly, the argument is like Mt. Trashmore—a big pile of garbage. Corporations are not in business to save consumers money. Corporations are in business to make the highest

profit possible. Thus, they sell their products and services for the highest prices market conditions of supply and demand allow. Given the market price, higher costs mean lower profits. By expanding Mt. Trashmore wider and higher, Waste Management can



lower their costs and thereby increase their profits. On their website, WM brags that in 2024 they increased their profit margin to 29.7% by reducing transportation costs—exactly what they are trying to do with the landfill expansion. As a giant corporation operating in a small city environment, WM has a lot of money which can buy a lot of political influence to get their way.

The day before the Broward County Commissioners were scheduled to vote on the expansion proposal, Waste Management met with Coconut Creek City Commissioners trying to get them to support the expansion. WM offered the city financial "incentives" (some might call it a bribe) if only they would endorse the project. On the urging of Wynmoor Council President and Coconut Creek Commissioner, Jackie Railey, the Coconut Creek Commissioners turned down the WM "incentives" - deciding instead to protect our health. Deerfield Beach Commissioners did the same. Wynmoor, Coconut Creek and Deerfield Beach mobilized residents and elected officials to come to the Broward Commissioners meeting on November 12th to loudly object to the plan. What was supposed to be a quick vote in favor of WM didn't happen. In the face of the strong opposition, the Commission voted to postpone their decision until the January 28th meeting –ostensibly after a report from the Solid Waste Commission is supposed to come out.


November 12th was a partial and temporary victory, but WM is not going to give up easily. They will try to push their money and political influence to get what they want. They will try to divide Coconut Creek and Deerfield Beach from the other cities of Broward County who are not directly affected by the health hazards of Mount Trashmore. We will have to fight harder.

If we fight, there is no guarantee we will win. But if we don't fight, it is guaranteed that we will lose. So, let's plan on turning out to the Broward Commissioners meeting on January 28th. Let's do whatever we have to do to protect our health and quality of life by stopping the expansion of Mount Trashmore.

What Legal Documents Are Most Important Now?

The pandemic changed almost everything. But certain legal documents are more important than ever.

If you need to be hospitalized in Florida, it is imperative that you have a Designation of Health Care Surrogate and Living Will with proper wording so there will be no problems. Do not rely on generic forms obtained online. Florida hospitals are requiring specific HIPAA compliant language not found on generic forms. Your Surrogate will be able to make medical decisions for you if you are unable to communicate.

Even if the hospital does not allow any visitors, your Surrogate will be able to talk

to the doctors and make decisions on the phone or e-mail. Your Surrogate does not need to be present in the hospital. All your Surrogate needs to do is e-mail or fax a copy of your document to the hospital. If there is no hope to save you, that Surrogate would be authorized to "pull the plug" based on the Living Will.

The Durable Power of Attorney is also important to allow someone to take over your legal and financial affairs. The Florida law changed in 2011. If you have an old Durable Power of Attorney, it should be redone. Again, do not rely on generic forms. Our current Power of Attorney is 26 pages to conform to Florida law.



If you are married, you still need to do a Health Care Surrogate, Living Will and Power of Attorney.

If you should die, your Will or Revocable Living Trust will determine who inherits your assets. The Trust is important to consider if you own your home or other real estate, because it avoids Probate. Probate can tie up your property for many months and prevent your heirs from selling without a Court Order. They would have to continue to pay taxes, maintenance, mortgage, utilities etc. in addition to thousands of dollars in attorney fees and court costs. A Life Estate Deed is another option to consider to avoid probate. Your attorney can discuss the

different options and the benefits of each one.

Does My Homestead Exemption Automatically Renew?

After your initial application for Homestead Exemption has been approved, it automatically renews each year unless there is a change of ownership or eligible use of your homesteaded property. Each January, our office mails a Homestead Renewal Notice and "Change Card" to all Homesteaded properties. Florida law requires the property owner to notify the Property Appraiser of any change which may affect homestead eligibility. This "Change Card" provides an easy way to communicate these important changes to our office.

If there are NO changes to the use and/or ownership of your property, simply keep the card as your receipt that your Homestead Exemption has automatically renewed for another year. However, if there are changes, please mark the Change Card accordingly when you receive it and return it to our office.

If your name is not printed in the "Homesteaded Owners" section on this card, it means you are not protected by Homestead Exemption at this property. You may be on title to your property, but not receiving Homestead Exemption. If you are eligible for Homestead Exemption on this property, but your name is not listed in the Homesteaded owner section of the renewal you must complete your own Homestead Exemption application. You can apply online at web.bcpa.net and click on "Exemptions & Classifications."

If you are a co-owner, surviving spouse, trust beneficiary or otherwise believe you are eligible for this exemption, you must file your own Homestead Exemption application to receive the benefit. If you have any questions relating to the death of the owner, the Change Card or need assistance in filing for Homestead or other tax-saving exemptions, please visit our website at web. bcpa.net or contact our Customer Service Department at 954-357-6830.

Where Did My Portability Savings Go?

A portability deduction is only posted to your property record page in the first year you receive your new Homestead Exemption. The portability savings from the first year form the basis of your new Save Our Homes value on a going forward basis and -- in subsequent years -- will rise or fall based upon market just value changes and the 3% cap, as your new Save Our Homes value has incorporated your portability savings. When our website is updated to display subsequent year property values, your portability deduction is no longer shown independently because it is already factored into your new Assessed/Save Our Homes value.

The Joy of Being Immersed In The Study Of Medieval Art At Milan's Brera Art Museum

In late November, I spent one fine day being immersed in the study of splendid works of Art at Milan, Italy's Brera Art Museum. Originally the Brera was a late 16th Century Palace built by the Jesuits on the grounds of San Maria de Brera Humiliti Monastery. The Jesuits used this palace as a cultural center by creating a top notch school, library, and astronomical center. I received this information by reading, "Milan and The Lakes" a travel book produced by DK Eyewitness Travel-Penguin Random House. Since 1809, the Brera has been an art museum featuring stellar paintings produced by European Painters.

Since the Brera's collection is so prodigious, I have restricted this review to its splendid works of Art from the 13th Century to 1425 AD-Medieval Period. All of these works of Art have devotional themes. Most of the works that I discussed employed tempera on wood panel.

From the 13th Century, Master of San Verano's "Saint Veranus with 2 Angels and 6 Scenes from Saint Veranus' life" was an auspicious start to my Medieval Art Studies that day. Saint Verano was a French Saint who was a Bishop Saint, famous for conquering a menacing dragon. This painting has Byzantine characteristics.

The following 14th Century Italian Paintings especially captivated me;

Barnaba Da Modena's "Adoration of Shepherds" (Genoese Master, painting has a combination of Byzantine and Naturalistic Characteristics), Giovanni Da Milano's "Christ Enthroned With Angels in Adoration," Ambrogio Lorenzetti's "Madonna and Christ Child" (a fine exemplar of Sienese Medieval Painting), Lorenzo Veneziano's "Madonna and Child With Saint Anthony Abbott, Saint Victor, St. Catherine of Alexandria, St. Nicholas, St. Mark, and St. Lucy," shows Byzantine influence in Venetian Art in the 14th Century, Giovanni Baronzio's "Scenes from Life of Saint Columba" (Riminese Master, Saint Columba brought Christianity

to Scotland), Bernardo Daddi's "Saint Lawrence" (important Florentine Master), Bartolomeo and Jacopino da Reggio's "Reliquary Triptych With Crucifixion, Annunciation with 30 Figures of Saints," a very punctilious painting to say the least. Giovanni Da Bologna's "Madonna and Child Enthroned With Angels," Master of Misericordia's "Evangelist in Art of Writing," a very naturalistic painting, Andrea Di Bartolo and Giorgio di Andrea's "Polytych With Coronation of Virgin" and Master of Mocchirolo's "Frescoes of Oratory of Mocchirolo," among others.

From the very early 15th Century, I appreciated fine paintings by Niccolo Di Pietro "Coronation of Virgin," International Gothic, Venetian Naturalistic Painting, Gentile Da Fabriano "Crucifixion," and the Spanish Primitive Painter, Pere Serra "Annunciation, Valencia." By the time these paintings were produced the Papacy had already returned to Rome, after being based in Avignon, France from 1309 to 1377.

The days that I spent at the Brera were very enlightening and I am thankful that I had the privilege of being there.





Breaking The Silence

January marks National Human Trafficking Prevention Month—a month set aside to raise awareness about a pervasive crime that often occurs in plain sight within our communities. While many envision victims as children or women sold into slavery or the sex trade, the reality is far more complex. Human trafficking transcends age, gender and race, encompassing both forced labor and sexual exploitation.

The Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) Internet Crimes Against Children/Human Trafficking Unit (HTU) is dedicated to identifying instances of human trafficking, rescuing victims and empowering communities to join the fight against this heinous crime. The HTU investigates intricate cases of exploitation, often rooted in emotional and financial

manipulation, working relentlessly to bring perpetrators to justice and provide support to those affected.

A notable example of HTU's work is Operation Suite 16, a two-day antitrafficking operation in partnership with local and state agencies. During the operation, HTU identified and assisted adult trafficking victims, connecting them to critical resources such as shelter, medical care and counseling to help them rebuild their lives. The operation also led to the arrests of individuals who targeted these vulnerable young women, exploiting their struggles with homelessness and addiction and coercing them into commercial sex acts, drug sales and fraudulent activities. This effort highlights the value of multi-agency operations and the meticulous work required to uncover and dismantle these operations.

Strong community partnerships are also critical to solving human trafficking cases. Through initiatives like the Stop Abuse, Fight Exploitation (S.A.F.E.)



Initiative, the HTU collaborates with prosecutors, code enforcement, local governments, regulatory agencies, homeowners and community leaders. Together, they work to identify, investigate and shut down sexually illicit businesses while preventing the recruitment of future victims.

The coordinated efforts of these operations and partnerships underscore the critical importance of interagency collaboration and community education. In addition to enforcement efforts, raising public awareness remains one of the most powerful tools in combating human trafficking. The HTU actively engages with neighborhoods, schools and organizations to educate the public on recognizing the warning signs of human trafficking, including isolation, poor physical health

or lack of financial control, and who to call for help.

The BSO HTU remains steadfast in its mission to combat this crime, support survivors and protect the vulnerable. Through enforcement, education and collaboration, we can make a meaningful difference and put an end to human trafficking in our communities. Let us commit to being vigilant, compassionate and proactive in this crucial fight.

Sex, Sex, Sex. Got your attention now. Have you ever considered how Judaism thought about how individuals view themselves? This month we quote an article by Rachel Scheinerman, titled "The Eight Genders in the Talmud."

"Judaism has recognized nonbinary persons for millennia. Thought Binary gender was a modern concept? Think again. The ancient Jewish understanding of gender was far more nuanced than many assume.

The Talmud, a huge and authoritative compendium of Jewish legal traditions, contains in fact no less than 8 gender designations including:

- 1. Zachar, Male.
- 2. Nekevah, Female.
- 3. Androgynos, having both male and female characteristics.
- 4. Tumtum, lacking sexual characteristics.
- 5. Aylonit hamah, identified female at birth but later naturally developing male characteristics.
- 6. Aylonit adam, identified female at birth but later developing male characteristics through human intervention.
- 7. Saris hamah, identified male at birth but later naturally developing female characteristics.
- 8. Saris adam, identified male at birth and later developing female characteristics through human intervention.

In fact, not only did the rabbis recognize 6 genders that were neither male nor female, they had a tradition that the first human being was both. Versions

of this midrash are found throughout rabbinic literature according to the Talmud." It was thought that Adam had both male and female faces and sex organs.

"For the rabbis, the androgynous wasn't just a thing of mythic past. The androgynous was in fact a recognized gender category in their present - though not with two heads, only both kinds of sex organs. The term appears no less than 32 times in the Mishnah and 283 times in the Talmud. Most of these citations are not variations on this myth, but rather discussions that consider how Jewish law (Halakhah) applies to one who has both male and female sexual characteristics."

Scheinerman goes on to quote Rabbi Yose in the Mishnah about how difficult it was to decide what obligations could or could not be done by androgynous people. The nonbinary populations are lumped together with other groups which do not fit neatly into their preconceived notions. The tumtum were easier to figure out.

"The rabbis also recognized that some people's sexual characteristics can change with puberty, either naturally or through intervention. Less common than the Androgynos and Tumtum, but still found throughout rabbinic texts, are the Aylonit, who is born with organs identified as female at birth but develops male characteristics at puberty or no sex characteristics at all, and the Saris, who is born with male identified organs and later develops features recognized as female (or no sex characteristics). These changes can happen naturally over time (saris hamah) or with human intervention (saris adam)."

Most of the discussions quoted were of a legal nature, which was the focus of the rabbis.

"A non-binary person who does not have the same halachic status as a male or female but is something else that is best described as ambiguous or in between, presented a halachic challenge that was not particularly foreign for the Rabbis, who discuss analogs in the animal and plant kingdoms. For example, the rabbinic texts describe a koi as an animal that is somewhere between wild and domesticated- and an etrog- yes, the beautiful citron that is essential for Sukkot- as between a fruit and a vegetable. Because they do not fit easily into common categories, the koi and the etrog require a special halachic consideration. The Rabbinic understanding of the world was that most categories, be they animal, vegetable, or mineral are imperfect descriptors of the world, either as it is or as it should be."

We think we have come a long way and are very sophisticated in our understanding of the human body, but do we really know more than our ancient rabbis? Maybe they understood more than we do.

We hope we have given you something to think about and discuss without rancor, and putting aside your pre-conceived notions about sexual characteristics.




